Whether you're doing a challenge, celebrating a birthday, or simply want to support a cause close to your heart, it's quick and easy to create your own fundraising page for **Springboard** on JustGiving.

Follow these steps:

Step 1: Go to www.justgiving.com

Step 2: Log In or Sign Up

- If you already have a JustGiving account, log in.
- If not, select "Sign up" and create a free account using your name, email, and a password.
- Click on the "Start Fundraising" button.

Step 3: Choose a Charity

- When asked "Are you fundraising for a charity?", click Yes.
- Type The Springboard Charity into the search bar and select it.

Step 4: Select Your Event Type

- If you're doing an organised event (e.g. a marathon), choose the event from the list.
- If not, select "Doing your own thing" perfect for personal fundraising activities.

You can name your activity something personal, like:

- "Sarah's 5K for Springboard"
- "Tom's Birthday Fundraiser"
- "Bake Sale for Springboard"



Step 5: Create Your Page

Personalise your page by:

- Setting a fundraising target
- Adding a title and short story about why you're fundraising
- Uploading photos or videos to bring your page to life

Make it engaging so friends and supporters feel inspired to donate!

Step 6: Launch and Share

Once your page is ready, hit **Publish**, and start sharing it with:

- Friends, family, and colleagues
- On social media, WhatsApp, or by email

Don't forget to include your JustGiving link and say thank you to everyone who supports you.

How to Get a QR Code for Your JustGiving Page

Step 1: Log into Your JustGiving Account

Go to www.justgiving.com and sign in.

Step 2: Go to Your Fundraising Page

Click on "Your Fundraising" at the top of the page, and then select the fundraising page you want to use.



Step 3: Scroll to the Share Section

On your fundraising page:

- Scroll down until you see the "Share" options (or look in the sidebar on desktop).
- You should see icons for sharing via Facebook, Twitter, etc.
- Look for the QR code icon or a link that says "Print a poster" or "QR code" (it can vary slightly based on layout and device).

Step 4: Download the QR Code

- Click the QR code icon or the "Print a poster" option.
- A window will open with a ready-made QR code poster or standalone QR image.
- You can download or print it directly from there.
